## **VISION:**

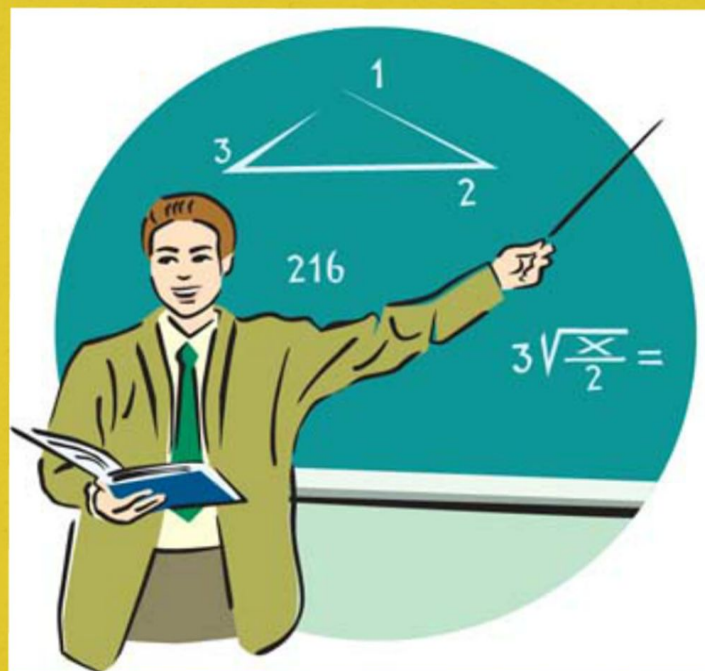

# IADC – Infrastructure & Resources

Infrastructure at Indian Academy Degree College – Autonomous plays a pivotal role in setting the right ambiance for students who are the primary stakeholders.

- There are ICT-enabled classrooms with smart boards, Seminar Halls, Laboratories, Board rooms, and auditoria for all curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular activities of the college.
- Indian Academy library has two floors and is equipped with sufficient computers to access Digital Library resources and upgraded with the latest Easylib 6.4a cloud version software. It has e- resources like DELNET, N-LIST, NDL, e-PG Pathshala, J -Gate Database, and DrillBit Anti-Plagiarism Check Software.
- Surveillance cameras are installed for monitoring purposes at the Library and Information Center. The entire campus is Wi-Fi enabled.
- The institute has a recording studio which also aids as an Audio-Visual center equipped with a high-speed internet facility and equipment for live streaming.
- The Learning Management System **LINWAYS** enables transparent and fool-proof academic and administrative operations.
- The college campus is maintained well with appropriate landscape, vermicompost units, solar panels and rainwater harvesting units.
- The campus includes lifts, ramps, wheelchairs, and other facilities for differently abled students. The campus has Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS) with a power backup facility.
- Exclusive parking lot for staff and students indicated by user-friendly signboards, 24x7 security services and 115 surveillance cameras enhance the utility of the campus.
